





Home or University?

The last couple of years have been difficult ones for students. Most students around the world have had to study at home, away from their friends and teachers. We asked 500 students at our university how they felt about studying at home or at university. The majority of students said they prefer to study at university, and a small number said they were not sure. We then asked their main reason for this choice.


The two most common reasons for preferring to study at university were that it was easier to study and meet friends. Only 15% said that meeting teachers was their main reason for preferring to study at university, and only 4% said it meant they could go to the library. This was two percentage points less than the number of people who said it meant they didn't need to use a computer all the time.

The two most common reasons for preferring to study at home were that there was no need to travel. followed by being able to study in your own time. 22% also found that it gave them more free time. Only 6% said it meant they had more time to study, the same as the number of people who said it gave them more time to

From this, we can see that studying at university is easier for many students, and that university social life is also very important for them too. At the same time, many students liked the freedom of studying at home and the extra time it gave them. As life goes back to normal, we will have to think about how we can make studying easier and more convenient for all our students. The university must do what it can to make it safe for students to meet their friends and develop their social skills.

On the 4th of February 1912, Franz Reichelt jumped off the Eiffel Tower in Paris, with a small crowd and about thirty journalists watching from below. This was not an attempt at suicide, and Reichelt hoped to land

Reichelt was a tailor and inventor who had a dream. He hoped to make a suit that could hide a (18) light-weight parachute. (20) were the latest exciting invention, and he was hoping to win a 10,000 franc prize - a huge amount of money at the time - and also be able to sell his invention around the world. It was less than ten years after the Wright brothers first successful flight. Although huge advances had been made, many pilots died in terrible crashes. There were demands to make the new industry safer and pilots wanted a parachute that could be used from a low flying plane.

He had tried out his invention by throwing shop mannequins from his fifth floor apartment building. ometimes it was successful, but not all of the time. He made adjustments to make it lighter, bigger, and faster. Many other people were also trying to (21) the prize, and some of them had large, rich companies helping them with their experiments. Reichelt felt the pressure.

He was (19) extremely confident in his invention and determined to prove how good it was to the world. He had to wait a year to get permission to use the Eiffel Tower, and only got it by saying he would use a mannequin. However, on the morning of the 4th, there were no mannequins to be seen. He had contacted journalists from all the top newspapers the day before, telling them that it would be him who would be wearing the suit and making the jump. A wave of excitement went through the crowd as, at 7 o'clock in the morning, he stepped out of his car wearing his invention, made a brief speech, and started up the Tower, hoping to make

It is not unknown for scientists and inventors to try out their experiments on themselves, although it is definitely not recommended. Marie Curie the two-time Nobel Prize winner would often test the effects of radiation on herself - and eventually died of cancer because of it. More (22), many scientists experimented on themselves in the hope of finding a vaccine for COVID-19.

Reichelt stood at the lowest platform of the Eiffel Tower, about 60 metres above the ground. His friends who had seen the broken mannequins from his earlier experiments tried to convince him not to make the jump. He waited 40 seconds with his foot on the edge before he jumped, perhaps thinking about becoming rich and famous, perhaps thinking about his death. He smiled as he jumped. Less than four seconds later, he lay dead at the bottom of the Eiffel Tower, his parachute only half open and wrapped around his broken body.
